2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 515

Assembly Bill 515 increases recycling grant funding provided to the Department of Natural Resources for issuance to responsible units of local government by \$2,300,000 for fiscal year 2015-16.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 changes the amount of additional funding in this fiscal year from \$2,300,000 to \$3,000,000.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Tittl on January 13, 2016. On January 20, 2016, the Assembly Committee on Urban and Local Affairs voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 and passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 7; Noes, 2.

On February 11, 2016, the Joint Committee on Finance also voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1, and passage of the bill as amended, by votes of Ayes, 11; Noes, 5.
