2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 772

Assembly Bill 772 consolidates several appropriations for workforce training programs into a single appropriation to the Department of Workforce Development (DWD), to be used for workforce training grants.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 deletes a provision allowing DWD to use workforce training grant appropriations for career and technical education incentive grants to school districts.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2

Assembly Amendment 2 requires DWD to include, in its annual report to the Governor and the Joint Committee on Finance, details of how it allocated and spent the funds appropriated to it for workforce training programs in that fiscal year.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendments 1 and 2 were offered by Representative Bernier on January 28, 2016. On February 10, 2016, the Assembly Committee on Workforce Development recommended adoption of both amendments, on votes of Ayes, 14; Noes, 0. The committee recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 10; Noes, 4.
