2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 783

The bill provides the Department of Health Services with a \$10,000 appropriation for the purpose of purchasing a virtual dementia tour license.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

The amendment increases the appropriation from \$10,000 to \$50,000, and specifies that the appropriation is made on a one-time basis.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was introduced by Representative Rohrkaste on January 28, 2016. On February 1, 2016, the Assembly Committee on Mental Health Reform recommended adoption of the amendment, on a vote of Ayes, 10; Noes 0. On the same day, the committee recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 10; Noes 0.

On February 4, 2016, the Joint Committee on Finance recommended adoption of the amendment, on a vote of Ayes, 14; Noes 0. On the same day, the committee recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 14; Noes 0.
