2015 SENATE BILL 171

Per current law, Senate Bill 171 eliminates a number of councils, boards and commissions that have not met since the September 15 preceding the Department of Administration (DOA) budget request. The bill also transfers the powers and duties of the Volunteer Fire Fighter and Emergency Medical Technician Service Award Board to the Secretary of DOA. Finally, the bill transfers the requirement to eliminate future councils, boards and commissions that do not meet prior to the September 15 preceding their budget request to the Department of Safety and Professional Services.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 removes the Automatic Fire and Sprinkler System Contractors and Journeymen Council from the bill, thus maintaining its current existence.

BILL HISTORY

Senate Amendment 1 was recommended for adoption by the Senate Committee on Government Operations and Consumer Protection on June 3, 2015, by a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0. The committee also recommended Senate Bill 171 for passage, as amended, on June 3, 2015, by a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2.
