



1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 162

February 28, 1995 - Introduced by Representatives BAUMGART, HAHN, HANSON, KAUFERT, RYBA, CULLEN, MORRIS-TATUM, BOYLE, LORGE and GROTHMAN. Referred to Committee on Government Operations.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 84.02 (5) (a); and **to create** 13.90 (6) of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** a “legislative hotline” service and placement of information regarding that
3 service on folded state highway maps.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, the department of transportation (DOT) periodically publishes folded state highway maps. This bill specifically authorizes the joint committee on legislative organization to provide a toll-free telephone service to be called a “legislative hotline” for the purpose of facilitating contacts between members of the legislature and members of the public and providing information concerning legislative organization and calendars, and requires DOT to include a brief explanation of any legislative hotline service on the folded highway maps.
