

## **1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 258**

March 23, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives BLACK, NOTESTEIN, ROBSON, HAHN, BOCK, RYBA, WILDER, BOYLE, CULLEN, BALDWIN, CARPENTER, HUBER, MORRIS-TATUM, R. POTTER and R. YOUNG, cosponsored by Senator RISSER. Referred to Committee on Environment and Utilities.

1 AN ACT to create 196.494 of the statutes; relating to: spent nuclear fuel disposal

facilities.

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## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the state from approving the construction of a spent nuclear fuel disposal facility until the federal nuclear regulatory commission issues a construction authorization for a high-level nuclear waste disposal repository or a construction license for a monitored retrievable storage facility. Current law does not specify any conditions under which the state may approve the construction of a spent fuel disposal facility.

The bill also directs that a spent nuclear fuel disposal facility located in this state may only accept nuclear waste from a nuclear power plant located at the site of the disposal facility.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 196.494 of the statutes is created to read:

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**196.494** Construction of nuclear waste disposal facilities limited. (1)

5 FEDERAL AUTHORIZATION. This state may not approve the construction of a spent fuel

6 disposal facility in this state unless the federal nuclear regulatory commission has

7 done any of the following:

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- (a) Issued the federal department of energy a construction authorization for a
   high-level nuclear waste disposal repository, as defined in 42 USC 10101 (18).
- 3 (b) Issued a license for the construction of a monitored retrievable storage
  4 facility, as defined in 42 USC 10101 (34).
- 5 (2) ON-SITE WASTE GENERATION. A spent fuel disposal facility in this state may
  only accept nuclear waste that is generated by a nuclear power plant, as defined in
  s. 196.493 (1), that is located at the site of the spent fuel disposal facility.
