## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 50

January 26, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives Black, Plache, Krug, Gronemus, Hubler, Bock, Springer, Riley, Wilder, Boyle, Cullen, Kreuser, Grobschmidt, Huber, Morris-Tatum and Kaufert, cosponsored by Senators Plewa, Risser and Chvala. Referred to Committee on Highways and Transportation.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 341.255 (2) (a) to (c) of the statutes; relating to: reducing
- 2 counter service fees collected by the department of transportation.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) collects counter service fees for vehicle registration and certificate of title transactions. DOT collects \$3 for a vehicle registration renewal and \$5 for a certificate of title and other vehicle registrations. These fees are in addition to the registration or title fee collected by DOT.

This bill reduces these counter service fees to \$1 for a vehicle registration renewal and \$2 for a certificate of title and other vehicle registrations.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 341.255 (2) (a) to (c) of the statutes are amended to read:
- 4 341.255 (2) (a) For each transaction relating to a certificate of title, \$5 \underset{\$\frac{5}{2}}\$.
  - (b) For each transaction relating to a registration not involving a certificate of title, \$5 \underset{\$2}\$; except that if the registration is solely a renewal of the previous year's registration the fee shall be \$3 \underset{\$1}\$.
  - (c) For each transaction which is a combination of a certificate of title and registration for the same vehicle, \$5 \underseps\_2.
