



1995 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 24

June 16, 1995 – Introduced by Representative BALDUS. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

1 ***To renumber and amend*** assembly rule 11 (9); ***to amend*** assembly rule 14 (1); and
2 ***to create*** assembly rule 11 (9) (b); **relating to:** requiring committee hearings
3 on proposed administrative rules.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution requires a committee chairperson to schedule a hearing on a proposed administrative rule referred to the committee if so requested by one-third of the members of the committee.

Resolved by the assembly, That:

4 **SECTION 1.** Assembly rule 11 (9), as affected by 1995 Assembly Resolution 2,
5 is renumbered assembly rule 11 (9) (a) and amended to read:

6 Assembly Rule 11 (9) (a) The chairperson shall determine, subject to par. (b),
7 when proposals or other business will be scheduled for public hearing or executive
8 action, and, subject to rule 17m, when committee actions shall be reported to the
9 assembly.
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11 **SECTION 2.** Assembly rule 11 (9) (b) is created to read:

12 Assembly Rule 11 (9) (b) The chairperson of a committee shall publish or post
13 a notice of a hearing to review a proposed administrative rule referred to the
14 committee if one-third of the members of the committee, in writing, so request the

1 chairperson within the rule's 30-day review period under section 227.19 (4) of the
2 statutes. If so requested, the chairperson shall publish or post the notice within the
3 rule's 30-day review period under section 227.19 (4) of the statutes.

4 **SECTION 3.** Assembly rule 14 (1) is amended to read:

5 Assembly Rule 14 (1) Any proposal referred to a committee, and any other
6 business relevant to its title, may at the discretion of the chairperson, subject to
7 assembly rule 11 (9) (b), be scheduled for public hearing.
