## **1995 SENATE BILL 255**

June 13, 1995 - Introduced by Senator Adelman. Referred to Committee on Transportation, Agriculture and Local Affairs.

AN ACT *to create* 110.08 (2m) of the statutes; **relating to:** the driving skills test for a commercial driver license or an endorsement to drive certain commercial vehicles.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, every applicant for a motor vehicle operator's license, or for authorization to drive a certain class or type of vehicle which the applicant is not authorized to drive, is required to successfully complete both a knowledge test and a driving skills test that demonstrates the applicant's ability to drive. This bill requires the department of transportation to make a driving skills test available throughout each working day during March, April and May to applicants for a commercial driver's license or for an endorsement to drive a commercial vehicle.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 110.08 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:
  - 110.08 (2m) The department shall offer driving skills tests for a commercial driver license or for an endorsement authorizing the operation of a commercial motor vehicle throughout each working day during the months of March, April and May, and during any additional period that the department determines is desirable.
