

1995 SENATE BILL 281

August 2, 1995 – Introduced by Senators WEEDEN, ELLIS and RUDE, by request of Governor Tommy G. Thompson. Referred to Committee on Education and Financial Institutions.

1 AN ACT relating to: the establishment of a staff development calendar for school

2 districts.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the department of public instruction to study the feasibility of establishing a statewide or cooperative educational service agency-wide staff development calendar for school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

4 (1) STAFF DEVELOPMENT CALENDAR. During the 1996–97 school year, the 5 department of public instruction shall study the feasibility of establishing a 6 statewide or cooperative educational service agency-wide staff development 7 calendar for school districts to identify the benefits of a more coordinated approach 8 to staff development and to explore how that would improve the effectiveness of staff 9 development efforts and support greater interaction between teachers of different 10 school districts. The department shall submit its report by January 1, 1997, to the 3

governor, and to the appropriate standing committees of the legislature in the
manner provided under section 13.172 (3) of the statutes.
