## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a property tax exemption for nonprofit organizations that rehabilitate residential property for sale to low-income persons.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 70.11 (4g) of the statutes is created to read: 570.11 (4g) HOUSING HELD FOR REHABILITATION AND SALE TO LOW-INCOME PERSONS. 6 Real property owned by a nonprofit organization that is rehabilitating the property 7 for sale to low-income persons for residential purposes. 8 SECTION 2. Effective date. 9 (1) This act takes effect on the January 1 after publication. 10
