

## **1995 SENATE BILL 412**

November 9, 1995 – Introduced by Senators DECKER and BRESKE, cosponsored by Representatives MUSSER, BALDUS and KREUSER. Referred to Committee on Environment and Energy.

1 AN ACT to create 29.245 (4) (b) 3. and 29.245 (5) (b) 4m. of the statutes; relating

to: shining rough fish while fishing with a bow or a crossbow.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the shining of most wild animals is prohibited with certain exceptions. This bill allows the shining of rough fish by a person who is fishing for rough fish with a bow or a crossbow.
