- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 939.64 (2) of the statutes; **relating to:** wearing a bulletproof

vest while committing a felony and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, if a person commits a felony while wearing a bulletproof vest, the maximum term of imprisonment for the felony is increased by 5 years. This bill makes the increase 10 years.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3	SECTION 1. 939.64 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	939.64 (2) If a person commits a felony while wearing a bulletproof garment,
5	the maximum term of imprisonment prescribed by law for that crime may be in-
6	creased by $5 \underline{10}$ years.
7	SECTION 2. Initial applicability.
8	(1) This act first applies to offenses committed on the effective date of this sub-
9	section.
