## **1995 SENATE BILL 518**

February 1, 1996 – Introduced by Senators Risser, Clausing, Buettner, Huelsman, Burke, Darling and Chvala, cosponsored by Representatives Urban, Robson, Wirch, Baldwin, R. Young, Boyle, Otte, Turner, Notestein, Ryba, La Fave, Olsen, Plache and Wasserman. Referred to Committee on State Government Operations and Corrections.

AN ACT to renumber and amend 101.123 (2) (c); and to create 36.11 (27) and 101.123 (2) (c) 2. of the statutes; relating to: authorizing the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System to prohibit the use of cigarettes and tobacco products on property that is subject to its jurisdiction.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law does not specifically authorize or prevent the adoption by the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System (board) of a prohibition against the use of cigarettes and tobacco products on property that is subject to the board's jurisdiction. This bill authorizes the board to prohibit the use of cigarettes and tobacco products on property that is subject to its jurisdiction.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Section 1.** 36.11 (27) of the statutes is created to read:

36.11 **(27)** Prohibition of tobacco. The board may prohibit the use of cigarettes, as defined in s. 139.30 (1), and tobacco products, as defined in s. 139.75 (12), on property that is subject to its jurisdiction.

**SECTION 2.** 101.123 (2) (c) of the statutes is renumbered 101.123 (2) (c) (intro.) and amended to read:

101.123 (2) (c) (intro.) This section does not limit the any of the following:

1. The authority of any county, city, village or town to enact ordinances or of any
school district to adopt policies that, complying with the purpose of this section,
protect the health and comfort of the public.
<b>Section 3.</b> 101.123 (2) (c) 2. of the statutes is created to read:
101.123 (2) (c) 2. The authority of the board of regents of the University of
Wisconsin System under s. 36.11 (27) to prohibit the use of cigarettes and tobacco
products on property that is subject to its jurisdiction.
