## **1995 SENATE RESOLUTION 4**

February 1, 1996 – Introduced by Senator WEEDEN. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1	<b>Relating to:</b> recognizing and affirming the original charter of Beloit College.
2	Whereas, Beloit College, located in the city of Beloit, was chartered on February
3	2, 1846, through an official act of the Wisconsin territorial legislature; and
4	Whereas, Beloit College was the first college or university in Wisconsin; and
5	Whereas, Beloit College was founded by Yale University graduates as the
6	"Yale-of-the-West"; and
7	Whereas, Beloit College represents a student body of 1,150 students from 42
8	countries and all 50 states; and
9	Whereas, Beloit College has served the citizens of this state and the nation and
10	others from around the world with distinction for the past 150 years; now, therefore,
11	be it
12	<b>Resolved by the senate, That</b> the senate does hereby recognize and affirm the
13	original charter set forth for Beloit College on February 2, 1846; and, be it further
14	Resolved, That the senate further acknowledges this state's gratitude to
15	Beloit College for its exemplary efforts in educating the citizens of this state and the
16	nation and others from around the world for the past 150 years.
