- 2 counter service fees collected by the department of transportation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) collects counter service fees for vehicle registration and certificate of title transactions. DOT collects \$3 for a vehicle registration renewal and \$5 for a certificate of title and other vehicle registrations. These fees are in addition to the regular registration or title fee collected by DOT.

This bill reduces these counter service fees to \$1 for a vehicle registration renewal and \$2 for a certificate of title and other vehicle registrations.
