

1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 107

February 10, 1998 - Introduced by Representatives JENSEN, FOTI and KUNICKI.

1	Relating to: commending S	State Auditor	Dale Cattanach	on the occasion	of his
2	retirement.				

Whereas, Dale Cattanach began his career in public service as the first director of the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, serving from 1963 to 1977 and establishing the bureau as a nonpartisan source of fiscal and program information and analyses for the Wisconsin legislature and in particular the Joint Committee on Finance; and

7 Whereas, he was appointed secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and served in that position with distinction from 1977 to 1979; and 8 9 Whereas, he became state auditor on January 1, 1979, and has led this 10 nonpartisan service agency for the past 19 years, creating a highly respected bureau 11 that consistently provides the legislature, and in particular the Joint Legislative 12 Audit Committee, with assurances that financial transactions and program 13management decisions are made effectively, efficiently and in compliance with state 14 law and that state agencies carry out the policies of the legislature and governor; and

6	Whereas, his public service has won him numerous awards and honors,
7	including the Lifetime Achievement Award in Program Evaluation given by the
8	National Conference of State Legislatures and the Public Administrator of the Year
9	award from the Wisconsin Capital Chapter of the American Society for Public
10	Administration; and
11	Whereas, his compassion for others is recognized by his countless hours of
12	volunteer work for various organizations in the state; and
13	Whereas, he has been a trusted source of information for legislators, others in
14	state government and the public because of his devotion to the highest standards of
15	public service, his common sense, his intellect and his hard work; and
16	Whereas, his integrity, strength of character, dedication to public service and
17	outstanding service to the legislative branch of Wisconsin government embody the
18	ideal of public service; and
19	Whereas, Dale Cattanach will retire from public service on February 28, 1998;

22	Wisconsin legislature congratulate Dale Cattanach on his almost 35 years of
23	outstanding public service, commend the distinguished service that he has rendered
24	to them and to the citizens of the state and extend to him their best wishes for his
