## 1999 SENATE BILL 278

November 4, 1999 – Introduced by Senators DECKER and A. LASEE, cosponsored by Representative AINSWORTH. Referred to Committee on Economic Development, Housing and Government Operations.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 32.03 (1) of the statutes; relating to: allowing property owned
- 2 by the state to be condemned.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, an entity with the power of condemnation may not condemn property owned by the state or by a municipality, public board or commission. This bill allows property owned by the state to be condemned.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 32.03 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 32.03 (1) The general power of condemnation conferred in this subchapter does
- 5 not extend to property owned by the state, a municipality, public board or
- 6 commission, nor to the condemnation by a railroad, public utility or electric
- 7 cooperative of the property of either a railroad, public utility or electric cooperative
- 8 unless such power is specifically conferred by law, provided that property not to

1 exceed 100 feet in width owned by or otherwise under the control or jurisdiction of  $\mathbf{2}$ a public board or commission of any city, village or town may be condemned by a 3 railroad corporation for right-of-way or other purposes, whenever a city, village or town by ordinance consents thereto. This subchapter does not apply to the 4  $\mathbf{5}$ acquisition by municipalities of the property of public utilities used and useful in 6 their business, nor to any city of the 1st class, except that every such city may conduct  $\mathbf{7}$ any condemnation proceedings either under this subchapter or, at its option, under 8 other laws applicable to such city.
