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## **2001 SENATE BILL 198**

June 5, 2001 – Introduced by Senators Erpenbach, Baumgart, Roessler and Schultz, cosponsored by Representatives Powers, Hebl, Gronemus, Hahn, J. Lehman, Miller, Olsen, Petrowski, Sherman, Skindrud and Townsend. Referred to Committee on Universities, Housing, and Government Operations.

1 AN ACT to amend 60.77 (6) (a) of the statutes; relating to: raising the bidding

threshold for public works contracts let by a town sanitary district.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Generally under current law, a town sanitary district commission is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$5,000 to the lowest responsible bidder. Also under current law, in general, a county is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$25,000 to the lowest responsible bidder, and a city, village, or town is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$15,000 to the lowest responsible bidder.

This bill increases the bidding threshold for a public works contract let by a town sanitary district commission from \$5,000 to \$15,000 before the lowest responsible bidder requirements apply.

**Section 1.** 60.77 (6) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

60.77 **(6)** (a) Let contracts for any work or purchase that involves an expenditure of \$5,000 \$15,000 or more to the lowest responsible bidder in the manner

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prescribed by the commission.	Section 66.0901 applies to contracts let under the	iis

#### SECTION 2. Initial applicability.
