## 2001 SENATE BILL 314

November 7, 2001 – Introduced by Senators GEORGE, RISSER, HANSEN, BURKE and WIRCH, cosponsored by Representatives POCAN, MUSSER, GRONEMUS, SYKORA, MILLER, BLACK, YOUNG, COGGS, COLON, SINICKI and BERCEAU. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 AN ACT to create 38.12 (3) (e) of the statutes; relating to: the salaries of 2 technical college instructors.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires that the salary and fringe benefits of a technical college instructor who is employed on a part-time basis be prorated based on the salary and fringe benefits that the instructor would receive if he or she were employed full time.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **SECTION 1.** 38.12 (3) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 38.12 (3) (e) If a district board employs an instructor on a part-time basis, the
- 5 district board shall ensure that the person's salary and fringe benefits are prorated
- 6 based on the salary and fringe benefits that the person would receive if he or she were
- 7 employed by the district board as an instructor on a full-time basis.
- 8 SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

### **SENATE BILL 314**

1 (1) This act first applies to employees who are affected by a collective 2 bargaining agreement that contains provisions inconsistent with this act on the day 3 on which the collective bargaining agreement expires or is extended, modified, or 4 renewed, whichever occurs first.
