

2001 SENATE BILL 385

January 16, 2002 – Introduced by Senators ERPENBACH, PLACHE, WIRCH, MOEN, BURKE and SCHULTZ, cosponsored by Representatives REYNOLDS, UNDERHEIM, LEIBHAM, MUSSER, LASSA and ALBERS. Referred to Committee on Universities, Housing, and Government Operations.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 180.0122 (1) (x) of the statutes; and *to affect* 2001 Wisconsin 2 Act 16 section 9320 (1q); **relating to:** filing fees for domestic corporation 3 annual reports.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law the fee for filing a domestic corporation annual report is \$25, if the report is filed electronically, or \$40, if the report is filed on paper. Under this bill, the fee is \$25, regardless of the format of the report.
