1 AN ACT relating to: the Type 1 motorcycle, moped, and motor bicycle safety
2 program and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation administers a Type 1 motorcycle, moped, and motor bicycle safety program. This bill increases funding for the program for each fiscal year of the 2001–03 fiscal biennium by \$200,000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Appropriation changes.

(1) Motorcycle, moped, and motor bicycle safety program. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of transportation under section 20.395 (4) (aq) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001, the dollar amount is increased by \$200,000 for fiscal year 2001–02 and the

- for the Type 1 motorcycle, moped, and motor bicycle safety program.
