# **2001 SENATE BILL 398**

- AN ACT *to amend* 49.175 (1) (z) of the statutes; **relating to:** a community youth
- grant to the New Concept Self Development Center, Inc.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of workforce development (DWD) administers a community youth grant program to fund programs that improve the social, academic, and employment skills of youth who are eligible to receive assistance under the federal temporary assistance for needy families program. This bill requires DWD to provide a community youth grant of \$250,000 in each year of the 2001–03 fiscal biennium to the New Concept Self Development Center, Inc., to provide community youth opportunities programming.

## **SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.**

(1) Community youth grant for New Concepts Self Development Center, Inc. Notwithstanding section 49.175 (1) (z) of the statutes, as affected by this act, from the moneys allocated under section 49.175 (1) (z) of the statutes, as affected by this act, the department of workforce development shall provide a grant of \$250,000 in each fiscal year of the 2001–03 fiscal biennium to the New Concept Self Development Center, Inc., to provide community youth opportunities programming.
