



2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 173

March 18, 2003 - Introduced by Representatives LOEFFELHOLZ, HINES, MUSSER, HAHN, LADWIG, AINSWORTH, TOWNSEND, FREESE, BIES, OTT, PETROWSKI, MCCORMICK, SUDER and GRONEMUS, cosponsored by Senator LEIBHAM. Referred to Committee on Agriculture.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 20.866 (2) (s) of the statutes; and *to affect* 2001 Wisconsin Act
2 16, section 9107 (1) (m) 1.; **relating to:** constructing a veterinary diagnostic
3 laboratory and granting bonding authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the authorized general fund supported borrowing authority of the state by \$4,900,000 for the purpose of constructing a veterinary diagnostic laboratory located at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. The bill also increases the amount enumerated for the laboratory under the 2001-03 authorized state building program from \$20,000,000 to \$24,900,000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 20.866 (2) (s) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 20.866 (2) (s) *University of Wisconsin; academic facilities.* From the capital
6 improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the board of regents of the University of
7 Wisconsin System to acquire, construct, develop, enlarge or improve university
