



## 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 330

May 13, 2003 - Introduced by Representatives MILLER, TURNER, MUSSER and BERCEAU, cosponsored by Senator RISSER. Referred to Committee on Urban and Local Affairs.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 79.036 (2) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** consolidation  
2     incentive payments.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, beginning in 2004, counties and municipalities that agree to consolidate county or municipal services are eligible to receive consolidation incentive payments equal to 75% of the amount that the counties or municipalities save as a result of consolidating services. Under this bill, counties and municipalities that agree to consolidate county or municipal services are eligible to receive consolidation incentive payments equal to 75% of the amount that the counties or municipalities save as a result of consolidating services, plus the amount of any reduction in payments to such counties or municipalities that results from consolidating services.

1 eligible for a payment under this section shall receive one payment in the first year  
2 of the consolidation specified in the agreement submitted under sub. (1) (a) that is  
3 equal to 75% of the estimated savings to each such county or municipality that result  
4 from the consolidation, plus the amount of any reduction in payments under this  
5 subchapter to each such county or municipality that results from the consolidation.  
6 No county or municipality may receive more than one payment under this section  
7 related to the same consolidation agreement.
