



## 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 97

February 20, 2003 - Introduced by Representatives CULLEN, LADWIG, TURNER and BIES, cosponsored by Senators REYNOLDS and LAZICH. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 347.25 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** vehicles operated in a  
2     funeral procession.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current law generally prohibits any vehicle from being equipped with a flashing light. An exception to this prohibition permits the lead vehicle or a motorcycle escort in a funeral procession to be equipped with a flashing amber light, but the light may be used only when the vehicle is used as a lead vehicle or escort in the funeral procession.

This bill allows any vehicle being operated in or as an escort to a funeral procession to be equipped with a flashing amber light, but the light may be used only in the funeral procession.
