## **2003 SENATE BILL 163**

May 14, 2003 – Introduced by Senators Roessler, Ellis, Stepp, Plale, Wirch and Robson, cosponsored by Representatives Owens, Townsend, Ladwig, Jeskewitz, J. Wood, Van Roy, Krawczyk, Bies, Loeffelholz, Musser, Hines, Berceau, Gronemus, Miller and Zepnick. Referred to Committee on Education, Ethics and Elections.

AN ACT to create 115.28 (50) of the statutes; relating to: establishing a clearinghouse for information about special education transition services and vocational opportunities that are available in each county.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Department of Public Instruction to cooperate with the Department of Workforce Development and the Department of Health and Family Services in the establishment of a clearinghouse for information about the special education transition services and vocational opportunities that are available in each county. Each of the three departments must post information about the clearinghouse on its Internet site.
