

2003 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 70

May 11, 2004 – Introduced by Senator A. LASEE, cosponsored by Representative BIES. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1	Relating to: the life and military service of Marine Corporal Jesse Thiry.
2	Whereas, Corporal Jesse Thiry was born March 2, 1981, in Green Bay, and died
3	April 5, 2004, while bravely fighting for his country in Iraq as a member of the U.S.
4	Marine Corps; and
5	Whereas, Corporal Thiry loved the Wisconsin outdoors and enjoyed hunting,
6	fishing, and camping with family and friends; and
7	Whereas, Corporal Thiry graduated from Luxemburg-Casco High School in
8	2000; and
9	Whereas, Corporal Thiry joined the U.S. Marine Corps in November 2000, and
10	attended basic training at the Marine Corps Recruit Depot in San Diego, California;

12	Whereas, Corporal Thiry performed his infantry training at Camp Pendleton
13	and served as a weapons instructor in Quantico, Virginia; and
14	Whereas, Corporal Thiry was stationed in Japan until his deployment to Iraq
15	in March 2004; and

Whereas, Corporal Thiry loved his family, friends, community, and country, 1 $\mathbf{2}$ proudly serving the people of the United States in Iraq and receiving the Purple 3 Heart posthumously; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That the members of the $\mathbf{5}$ Wisconsin Legislature commend the devoted service that Corporal Jesse Thiry gave 6 unselfishly to his country, his state, and his community; express their sorrow at his 7 death; and extend their condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further
