2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 246

March 18, 2005 – Introduced by Representatives WIECKERT, KREIBICH, NISCHKE, JESKEWITZ, GRONEMUS, PETTIS, AINSWORTH, OTT, GUNDERSON, PETROWSKI, VOS and HUEBSCH, cosponsored by Senator REYNOLDS. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

AN ACT *to amend* 38.04 (4) (am); and *to create* 38.04 (4) (f) and 38.22 (7) of the statutes; **relating to:** admission standards for, and the curricula of, health occupation programs offered by technical colleges.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Technical College System Board, within a specified period, to develop admissions standards and a standard curriculum for each health occupation program offered by the technical college districts and ensure that all district boards adopt them.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4	SECTION 1. 38.04 (4) (am) of the statutes is amended to read:
5	38.04 (4) (am) The Except as provided in par. (f), the board shall not consider
6	any course of study for approval under par. (a) that has not first been approved by
7	the district board.

9	admission standards required by this act by the first day of the 60th month beginning
10	after the effective date of this subsection.
