Whereas, Lance Cpl. Warner had enrolled in and aspired to one day become a helicopter pilot and hoped to one day work for either the FBI or the CIA; and

Whereas, Lance Cpl. Warner will be remembered by his parents, Patrick and Mary Donahue, his sister, Kimberly Warner, and his other family and friends for his bravery and courage and will never be forgotten; and

Whereas, Lance Cpl. Warner will also be remembered in honor of his late grandparents Adelrich Kaelin, William Warner, and Donald and Marie Donahue; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the Wisconsin legislature commend the life of Lance Cpl. Richard Warner, express their sorrow at his death, and extend their condolences to his family and friends; and be it further
