2005 SENATE BILL 119

March 15, 2005 – Introduced by Senators Lazich, Leibham, Reynolds and Darling, cosponsored by Representatives Stone, Jensen, Wood, Krawczyk, Gundrum, Nischke, Hines, Vos, Albers, Pridemore, Hahn, Townsend, LeMahieu, Ainsworth, Freese and Davis. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Transportation.

AN ACT to amend 20.510 (1) (x); and to create 5.05 (16), 20.395 (5) (cr) and 343.50 (14) of the statutes; relating to: funding for identification cards provided without charge by the Department of Transportation and making appropriations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates an appropriation in the Department of Transportation (DOT) for the purpose of issuing and renewing identification cards without charge, and provides for the transfer to this appropriation account of up to \$250,000 per fiscal year of federal Help America Vote Act funds. Under the bill, DOT must certify to the Elections Board (board) its costs incurred in issuing identification cards without charge, and the board must certify to DOT the amount of costs that the board determines to be correct. The provisions of the bill are contingent upon the enactment of 2005 Assembly Bill 63 or 2005 Senate Bill 42.

Section 1. 5.05 (16) of the statutes is created to read:

SECTION 2. 20.395 (5) (cr) of the statutes is created to read:

20.395 **(5)** (cr) *Voter identification cards; state funds*. All moneys transferred from the appropriation account under s. 20.510 (1) (x) for the purpose of issuing and renewing identification cards without charge under s. 353.50 (5) and (6).

SECTION 3. 20.510 (1) (x) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.510 (1) (x) Federal aid. From the election administration fund, all moneys received from the federal government, as authorized by the governor under s. 16.54, to be used for election administration costs under P.L. 107–252 and to transfer to the appropriation account under s. 20.395 (5) (cr) a sum sufficient, not exceeding \$250,000 in any fiscal year, to fully fund the costs incurred by the department of transportation in issuing identification cards without charge under s. 343.50 (5) and (6), as approved by the elections board under s. 5.05 (16).

Section 4. 343.50 (14) of the statutes is created to read:

343.50 (14) CERTIFICATION OF COSTS INCURRED. The department shall certify to the elections board a statement of its costs incurred in issuing identification cards without charge under subs. (5) and (6).

SECTION 5. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) RECONCILIATION PROVISION. This act is void unless 2005 Wisconsin Act (Assembly Bill 63) or 2005 Wisconsin Act (Senate Bill 42) is enacted into law and
