2005 SENATE BILL 173

April 15, 2005 – Introduced by Senators RISSER and ROESSLER, cosponsored by Representatives OWENS, BIES, BOYLE, FREESE, HINES, LEHMAN and OTT. Referred to Committee on Health, Children, Families, Aging and Long Term Care.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 101.123 (1) (ar) of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting 2 smoking in the vicinity of the state capitol building.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits smoking in the immediate vicinity of the state capitol building, as determined by rule of the Department of Administration. Currently, the immediate vicinity of the state capitol building does not include any area that is more than one fathom from the state capitol building.

This bill deletes this prohibition and, instead, prohibits smoking within 25 feet of the state capitol building.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3	SECTION 1. 101.123 (1) (ar) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	101.123 (1) (ar) "Immediate vicinity of the state capitol" means the area
5	directly adjacent to any location within 25 feet of the state capitol building, as
6	determined by rule of the department of administration. "Immediate vicinity of the
