1 **Relating to:** commending Peter J. Dykman for his many years of service to the

4 career of service to the Wisconsin legislature; and

9 when he joined the Legislative Reference Bureau as a bill drafter in 1970; and

10 Whereas, Peter's talent was quickly recognized, and he served as director of
11 legislative attorneys for the Legislative Reference Bureau from 1975 to 1994, as
12 deputy chief from 1986 to 1994, as acting chief from 1994 to 1998, and as general
13 counsel and deputy chief until his retirement; and
