| 6 | Neenah, attended the University of Wisconsin-Fox Valley and the University of |
| 7 | Wisconsin–La Crosse, and enlisted in the United States Army in 2005; and |
| 8 | Whereas, Jon served with distinction in the United States Army 1st Cavalry |
| 9 | Division, Fort Hood, Texas, and was in his first tour of duty in Iraq; and |
| 10 | Whereas, Jon's family and fellow citizens are very proud of him and know that |
| 11 | he died doing what he wanted to do: serve the nation and fight for freedom; and |
| 12 | Whereas, Jon embodied the Army's core values of loyalty, duty, respect, selfless |
| 13 | service, honor, integrity, and personal service and he will be sorely missed; now, |
| 14 | therefore, be it |
