2007 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 98

March 4, 2008 – Introduced by Senators Sullivan, Taylor, Darling and Roessler, cosponsored by Representatives Cullen, Jeskewitz, Grigsby, Kessler and Albers. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.
