



## 2009 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 19

March 23, 2010 – Introduced by Representative HUBLER. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **To amend** assembly rule 21 (1); **relating to:** requiring 15 authors for an assembly  
2             resolution to reprimand, censure, or expel a member.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This resolution amends the assembly rules to require that any resolution to reprimand, censure, or expel an officer or member of the assembly must have at least 15 authors.

3             **Resolved by the assembly, That:**

4             **SECTION 1.** Assembly rule 21 (1) is amended to read:

5             **ASSEMBLY RULE 21 (1)** Any resolution to reprimand, censure, or expel an officer  
6             or member of the assembly shall be referred to a special committee on ethics and  
7             standards of conduct, convened for the purpose of holding one or more public  
8             hearings on the resolution and submitting the committee's recommendation to the  
9             assembly, only if at least 15 members of the assembly author the resolution. The

1 special committee shall consist of 3 members of the majority party and 3 members  
2 of the minority party, appointed as are the members of standing committees.
