



2009 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 59

January 26, 2010 - Introduced by Senator LEHMAN, cosponsored by Representatives MASON, TURNER and VOS. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** the life and military service of United States Army Reserve Captain
2 Russell Seager.

3 Whereas, Captain Russell Seager was born in Reedsburg, and died on
4 November 5, 2009, as a result of the shootings at Fort Hood; and

5 Whereas, Captain Russell Seager earned both his bachelor of science degree in
6 nursing and his master of science degree in nursing from Marquette University; and

7 Whereas, Captain Russell Seager was a nurse practitioner who joined the Army
8 four years ago to help veterans returning to civilian life; and

9 Whereas, Captain Russell Seager earned his doctorate degree in alternative
10 medicine, and stressed wellness of mind, body, and spirit; and

11 Whereas, Captain Russell Seager helped veterans struggling with
12 post-traumatic stress disorder at the Clement J. Zablocki Veterans Affairs Medical
13 Center in Milwaukee; and

14 Whereas, Captain Russell Seager taught classes at Bryant & Stratton College
15 in Milwaukee since 2005; and
