2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 256

September 15, 2011 – Introduced by Representatives E. COGGS, YOUNG and TOLES.
Referred to Committee on Labor and Workforce Development.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 20.445 (1) (ft) and 106.32 of the statutes; **relating to:** a grant
2 to Milwaukee County to assist men of color in obtaining employment and
3 making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) administers various programs to assist individuals in obtaining employment. This bill requires DWD to provide a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 in each fiscal biennium to Milwaukee County for that county's task force on work reform for men to assist men of color in obtaining employment.

13 that county's task force on work reform for men to assist men of color in obtaining
