2011 SENATE RESOLUTION 12

March 3, 2011 – Introduced by Senator S. FITZGERALD. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1	Relating to: imposing penalties and costs on Senator Chris Larson for being absent
2	without leave.
3	Whereas, Senator Chris Larson of the 7th Senate District has been absent
4	without leave from the March 3, 2011, and the March 4, 2011, session days; and
5	Whereas, Senate Rule 13n imposes penalties and costs on any member of the
6	senate who is absent without leave for two or more session days; and
7	Whereas, pursuant to Senate Rule 13n, Senator Larson has received notice by
8	publication of both this resolution and the senate calendar which includes
9	consideration of this resolution that he is subject to such penalties and costs; and
10	Whereas, the sergeant at arms has delivered a copy of both this resolution and
11	the senate calendar which includes consideration of this resolution to Senator
12	Larson's senate office, thereby providing additional notice to the senator, pursuant
13	to Senate Rule 13n; and
14	Whereas, pursuant to Senate Rule 13n, Senator Larson has an opportunity to
15	be heard, on the session day on which this resolution is before the senate, on the

matter of whether or not penalties and costs for being absent without leave may be
 imposed on the senator; and

Whereas, upon adoption of this resolution, Senator Larson is responsible for the
penalties and costs imposed under Senate Rule 13n for each day that the senator is
absent without leave; now, therefore, be it

6 **Resolved by the senate, That** pursuant to Senate Rule 13n, Senator Chris 7 Larson shall pay the penalties and costs imposed under Senate Rule 13n for being 8 absent without leave for two or more session days and that the total amount of such 9 penalties and costs shall be calculated by the senate chief clerk and submitted to the 10 president who shall deliver that total, in writing, to Senator Chris Larson's senate 11 office for immediate payment.
