## 2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 889

March 26, 2014 – Introduced by Representatives Wachs, Sargent, Ohnstad and Young, cosponsored by Senators Vinehout and Lehman. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

AN ACT *to create* 20.285 (1) (c), 20.292 (1) (cm), 36.27 (1) (c) and 38.24 (9) of the statutes; **relating to:** providing free tuition and fees for resident students enrolled in technical colleges and University of Wisconsin college campuses and making an appropriation.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Beginning in the 2014–15 academic year, this bill directs the University of Wisconsin System Board of Regents to ensure that resident students enrolled in a two-year college campus attend free of tuition and fees.

Similarly, the bill directs the Wisconsin Technical College System Board to ensure that, beginning in the 2014-15 academic year, resident students enrolled in a technical college attend free of tuition and fees.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 SECTION 1. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert 6 the following amounts for the purposes indicated:
