



2013 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 96

February 13, 2014 – Introduced by Representatives MARKLEIN, BROOKS, KNODL, MURPHY, MURTHA, TRANEL and WILLIAMS. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** commemorating the fiftieth anniversary of the 1964 Dodgeville
2 Dodgers high school boys basketball state championship.

3 Whereas, the 1964 Dodgers competed with more than four hundred other
4 schools across the state for a spot in the final championship; and

5 Whereas, the team of young men from the small-town school of only four
6 hundred students competed in a bracket against schools with as many as 1,800
7 students; and

8 Whereas, the Dodgers, through a combination of hard work, dedication, and
9 commitment, finished their season at 26-0 on March 21, 1964, with a win over
10 Milwaukee North, 59-45; and

11 Whereas, Dodgeville coach John “Weenie” Wilson built a team of small-town,
12 dedicated kids, and coached them to unprecedented success and state and national
13 prominence; and
