October 22, 2013 - Introduced by Senators VUKMIR, HARRIS, SCHULTZ, WIRCH and RISSER, cosponsored by Representatives SEVERSON, TRANEL, PASCH, BALLWEG, DANOU, JAGLER, SANFELIPPO, STEINEKE, TITTL, BERNIER, BEWLEY, BIES, BROOKS, CZAJA, HEBL, KAUFERT, KESTELL, LEMAHIEU, MURTHA, A. OTT, PETRYK, SPIROS, STRACHOTA and WACHS. Referred to Committee on Health and Human Services.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 20.435 (5) (cd) and 46.535 of the statutes; **relating to:** grants
2 for crisis intervention team training and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services (DHS) to award grants for mental health crisis intervention team training for law enforcement agencies and correctional officers. The total amount of the moneys to be awarded as grants in each fiscal biennium is \$250,000 under the bill, and DHS pays those grants from general purpose revenue.
