- November 25, 2013 Introduced by Senator VINEHOUT, cosponsored by Representatives DANOU, WACHS, GOYKE, KOLSTE, BERNARD SCHABER, SHANKLAND, SINICKI, BERCEAU, WRIGHT, POPE, DOYLE, C. TAYLOR, KAHL, CLARK, JORGENSEN, OHNSTAD, BARNES, HEBL, MILROY and BILLINGS. Referred to Committee on Workforce Development, Forestry, Mining, and Revenue.
- 1 AN ACT relating to: monitoring industrial sand mining and processing 2 operations and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes eight full time equivalent positions to the Department of Natural Resources for monitoring industrial sand mining and processing operations and provides funding for those positions from the environmental fund.

increased by \$893,600 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this
subsection takes effect to provide funding for the positions authorized in this
subsection.
