1 **AN ACT to create** 447.02 (1) (g) of the statutes; **relating to:** regulation of mobile
2 dentistry and granting rule-making authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law authorizes the Dentistry Examining Board to promulgate rules regulating various aspects of the practice of dentistry in Wisconsin. This bill authorizes the Dentistry Examining Board to promulgate rules that regulate the provision of dental services out of mobile dentistry units and the use of portable dental equipment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 447.02 (1) (g) of the statutes is created to read:
4 447.02 (1) (g) Governing the standards and conditions for the provision of
5 dental services out of a mobile dentistry unit and the use of portable dental
6 equipment.
