2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 746

December 19, 2017 - Introduced by Representatives ANDERSON, CROWLEY, BROSTOFF, YOUNG, SUBECK, BERCEAU, SARGENT and SINICKI, cosponsored by Senators L. TAYLOR and BEWLEY. Referred to Committee on Judiciary.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 16.312 and 20.505 (7) (d) of the statutes; **relating to:** grants
2 to provide legal services to tenants in eviction actions, granting rule-making
3 authority, and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Administration to establish a grant program to provide funds to attorneys to provide legal services for low-income tenants in eviction actions or in actions in which the tenant alleges he or she was wrongfully evicted. Under the bill, the grant moneys may only be used to provide legal services to a tenant whose family has an income at or below 200 percent of the federal poverty line.
