### **2017 SENATE BILL 482**

October 27, 2017 - Introduced by Senators Erpenbach, Hansen, Risser, Vinehout, Larson and Ringhand, cosponsored by Representatives Sargent, Genrich, Zamarripa, Hebl, Hesselbein, Kolste, Anderson, Goyke, Shankland, Pope, C. Taylor, Spreitzer, Berceau, Novak, Crowley, Sinicki, Hintz, Billings and Fields. Referred to Committee on Elections and Utilities.

- 1 AN ACT **relating to:** increasing funding to the Elections Commission for elections
  2 administration positions and making an appropriation.
  - Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the amount appropriated to the Elections Commission by \$304,100 in each year of the 2017–19 biennium in order to increase the number of FTE positions authorized to the Elections Commission by 5.0 FTE positions.

In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the elections commission under section 20.510 (1) (a) of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2018–19 is increased by \$304,100 to increase the authorized FTE positions for the elections commission by 5.0 FTE GPR positions for the purpose of elections administration.
