## 2019 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 129

February 6, 2020 - Introduced by Representatives VOS and HINTZ, cosponsored by Senators FITZGERALD and SHILLING. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** congratulating the Wisconsin Hospital Association on its 100th  
2             Anniversary and declaring March 18, 2020, Wisconsin Hospital Day.

3             Whereas, the Wisconsin Hospital Association (WHA) was formed on September  
4     16, 1920, at the Pfister Hotel in Milwaukee “to promote the welfare of the people of  
5     the state” and be “of real value as a service organization to its members”; and

6             Whereas, within six months of formation, advocacy was an immediate priority  
7     of WHA, with the organization taking positions on bills up for debate in that session  
8     of the Wisconsin State Legislature; and

9             Whereas, today WHA is the unifying voice for Wisconsin hospitals and health  
10    systems, whose mission to advocate for the ability of its members to lead in the  
11    provision of high-quality, affordable, and accessible health care services has resulted  
12    in healthier Wisconsin communities; and

13            Whereas, WHA’s bipartisan work with the state legislature has allowed  
14    Wisconsin to take important steps to address this mission, including the passage and

1 enactment of key legislation to enhance quality, build the health care workforce,  
2 improve access to care, and support the health of the state's population; and

3 Whereas, the needs of Wisconsin's health care system, our citizens, and our  
4 employers have evolved greatly over the last 100 years, requiring close partnership  
5 between the Wisconsin Hospital Association, its members, and Wisconsin  
6 lawmakers; now, therefore, be it

7 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** WHA's issue  
8 expertise and partnership with both sides of the aisle have helped advance sound  
9 health care policy that expands access to high-quality care in Wisconsin; and, be it  
10 further

11 ***Resolved, That*** the Wisconsin State Legislature recognizes the contributions  
12 made by over 100,000 people working in Wisconsin hospitals, the thousands of  
13 hospital advocates who have worked with their elected officials over the past 100  
14 years, and the work of the Wisconsin Hospital Association to improve access,  
15 affordability, and quality in Wisconsin health care; and, be it finally

16 ***Resolved, That*** the Wisconsin State Legislature congratulates the Wisconsin  
17 Hospital Association on its 100th Anniversary and proclaims March 18, 2020, as  
18 Wisconsin Hospital Day.
