## 2019 SENATE BILL 76

March 1, 2019 – Introduced by Senators LARSON, BEWLEY, CARPENTER, JOHNSON and SMITH, cosponsored by Representatives SARGENT, ANDERSON, BROSTOFF, CABRERA, CONSIDINE, CROWLEY, EMERSON, OHNSTAD, SHANKLAND, SINICKI, SPREITZER, SUBECK, C. TAYLOR, VRUWINK and ZAMARRIPA. Referred to Committee on Elections, Ethics and Rural Issues.

1 AN ACT to amend 11.1101 (1) (a), 11.1101 (2) (a) and 11.1101 (figure) of the 2 statutes; relating to: decreasing individual and candidate committee 3 contributions for statewide officeholders.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill decreases the individual and candidate committee contribution limit from \$20,000 to \$10,000 for contributions made to candidates for governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, state treasurer, attorney general, state superintendent, or justice.

7	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 11.1101 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	11.1101 (2) (a) Candidates for governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state,
9	state treasurer, attorney general, state superintendent, or justice, \$20,000 \$10,000.
