DATE: July 31, 2014

1998 Senate Bill 298 (attached), relating to structured settlement agreements, appears to be the only legislative proposal introduced in Wisconsin relating to the transfer of structured settlement payments. The bill was introduced during the 1999 Legislative Session. The bill did not receive a hearing or any other legislative action during that session.¹

The bill was introduced prior to the enactment of the federal law governing the tax treatment of transfers of structured settlements. Its introduction also predated the 2000 Model State Structured Settlement Protection Act.² Instead, the bill was based on a 1998 model act.
