1	AN ACT to renumber 256.15 (10); and to create 256.15 (10) (b) of the statutes: $\frac{1}{2}$
2	relating to: reinstatement of a lapsed emergency medical technician license
3	or first responder certification.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This is a preliminary draft. An analysis will be provided in a subsequent version of this draft.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 256.15 (10) of the statutes is renumbered 256.15 (10) (a).

SECTION 2. 256.15 (10) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

256.15 (10) (b) A license or certificate issued under sub. (5), (7), or (8) that has been expired for over 6 months but less than 4 years from the date that renewal is required has lapsed. The individual shall comply with requirements established by the department by rule to reinstate a lapsed license or certification. The department

may impose a fee, in an amount determined by the department, for renewing a license or certification after the license or certification has expired or for reinstating a lapsed license. An individual whose license or certification has been expired for 4 years or more may reinstate the license or certification only if the individual has successfully completed the training and examination requirements for the initial license or certificate under sub. (6), (7), or (8).
